- **"Forever in Motion" exercise** takes place Tuesday and Thursday mornings, keeping us all moving in the colder months. They take the summer off to enjoy being outside.
- **Bingo** is held once a month for cash prizes.
- We hold **fundraising barbecues** several times a year and are looking forward to using the new barbecue purchased this year.

Our membership fee is \$25 a year.
