

## **Reports from April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2026, Regular Council Meeting**

### **Utilities**

Foreman Desrosiers reported that:

- He has ordered a replacement breaker for filter 2 at the water treatment plant and it should arrive in 2-4 weeks;
- He has started installing remote reading sensors on houses with newer residential water meters and will begin replacing older meters once the snow melts to allow easier access to curb stops if necessary; and,
- Delivery of gravel for filter bed number 1 of the biological filtration project is scheduled for next week.

### **Fire Department and First Responders**

Mayor Stobbe reported that the RM of Corman Park has indicated they will respond to AFD's request for a review of response territory after they have finished their current review of their Fire Bylaw.

### **Streets and Town Property**

Foreman Desrosiers reported that he will start addressing potholes once the weather is warm and dry consistently.

He also provided a quote from Wheatland Tractor for the purchase of a commercial mower which includes the estimated trade in value for the two John Deere mowers.

Councillor Nehring reported that the grant application for maintaining the urban forest is ready to submit. She also reported information regarding a cost sharing grant for removal and replacement of diseased and dying trees.

Councillor Stack provided information he learned at the "When Volunteers Run the Show" webinar. He recommended Council or committee meet annually with the Elks, BLRA, and Rink Board to review stewardship agreements, insurance, and discuss any concerns. Mayor Stobbe offered to schedule those meetings.

### **Finance**

CAO Montgomerie recommended that asbestos testing of the Elks Hall, Seniors Centre, Town Office, Rink, and old water treatment building be completed. As required by the Public Sector Accounting Board, any financial audits will be qualified until testing is completed and remediation costs are identified.

### **Waste Disposal**

CAO Montgomerie reported that:

- the old landfill will be open for the deposit of clean waste every second Saturday starting May 2<sup>nd</sup> through October 3<sup>rd</sup>;
- Spring Clean Up Days are scheduled for May 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> with large waste and metal recycling bins in the Sportsgrounds parking lot.

### **Rink, Cemetery, Sportsgrounds**

Councillor Theisen reported that the Asquith Soccer Club will be hosting a tournament at the sportsgrounds on June 6<sup>th</sup>.

### **Recreation Committee**

Mayor Stobbe reported that she and Mr. Summach are hoping to receive a project donation from the RM of Vanscoy No. 345 for upgrades to the rink bathrooms.

### **Town Personnel**

### **Policing**

CAO Montgomerie supplied 4<sup>th</sup> quarter stats and an invitation to an open house from the RCMP.
