

Reports from April 9, 2025, Regular Council Meeting

Utilities

Foreman Desrosiers reported on a watermain break in front of the Elk's Hall. The line into the building was also replaced during the repair. He also reported that the concrete pad for the new gas meter at the water treatment plant will be poured soon. On April 2nd the retention tank of the water treatment plant was emptied and cleaned of ~5 feet of iron sludge and a valve was replaced. Iron numbers in the water have decreased following this work.

Fire Department and First Responders

Councillor Wolfe reported that the Fire Department held ISC training on the weekend that was well attended. There was a Fire Chiefs meeting in Humboldt yesterday regarding changes proposed by Saskatchewan Public Safety Agency.

Streets and Town Property

Foreman Desrosiers reported that he is filling potholes as a stop-gap measure for the deep holes. He has been pumping water and pushing snow to decrease pooling.

CAO Montgomerie reported that the Town has received title for Lot 16 Blk 9 Plan F1840 through tax enforcement.

Finance

CAO Montgomerie reported that the Town recovered \$350.31 in PST and \$1391.36 in GST rebates that were missed from 2020-2024 through a review performed by LWA Tax.
