

## **Reports from June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025, Regular Council Meeting**

### **Utilities**

Foreman Desrosiers reported that he pumped 850,000 gallons out of the lagoon and that it shouldn't need to be done again until fall.

He also reported that work on the generator at the water treatment plant may cause a drop in water pressure for about 4 hours on Monday.

### **Fire Department and First Responders**

The Fire Committee reported that they plan to meet with the Fire Department to discuss budgeting, dispatch, and other policies.

Councillor Heck reported that he has spoken to other representatives regarding fire departments and he will reach out to them to discuss further.

### **Streets and Town Property**

Foreman Desrosiers reported that a tree fell on Cory Street and BTE hauled it away.

Councillor Nehring expressed concern that most of the Town trees are at the end of their life and suggested Council develop a plan to replace them.

Foreman Desrosiers reported that Raider Asphalt patched some potholes in Town.

### **Finance**

CAO Montgomerie reported that the CRA payroll audit went well.

She also reported that the finance committee will meet to discuss budget prior to the next regular council meeting.

### **Waste Disposal**

CAO Montgomerie reported that "Big Bin Days" went well and a larger amount of trash was removed this year versus last year.

Councillor Wolfe reported that five trailers of used tires were hauled away that weekend as well.

### **Rink, Cemetery, Sportsgrounds**

CAO Montgomerie reported that repairs to the damaged monuments at the Cemetery have been contracted to Summit Memorials.

Councillor Theisen reported that there is a large soccer tournament taking place at the sportsgrounds this weekend with up to 2000 people expected to attend. He also reported that the Soccer Club indicated on the map sent to attendees that parking is not allowed on Lunn Street.

### **Recreation Committee**

Mayor Stobbe reported that the Recreation Committee will meet June 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025, to review applications and follow ups for the SaskLotteries grant.

### **Town Personnel**

CAO Montgomerie reported that an interview with a candidate for the Foreman's Assistant position will be scheduled with the Personnel Committee prior to the next regular council meeting.
