

Reports from June 8th, 2026, Regular Council Meeting

Utilities

Foreman Desrosiers reported that:

- Water Security Agency was out on June 4th to complete the annual inspection and reported no issues. However it was too wet to visit the lagoon; and,
- There is an ongoing dig for a water leak on the 100 block of Main Street. The crew will be drilling a new line under the road on Thursday.

Fire Department and First Responders

Councillor Wolfe reported that the AFD Pig Roast went well and some AFD members brought one of the engines to the soccer tournament on the weekend.

Streets and Town Property

Foreman Desrosiers reported that:

- He has been gravelling roads, using 5 loads of gravel already; and,
- Raider asphalt will complete street patching on Main Street and other higher traffic areas next week.
