

Reports from May 13th, 2026, Regular Council Meeting

Utilities

Foreman Desrosiers reported that:

- The underdrain is installed in the first cell of the water treatment plant, the media is in storage, and they are now waiting on pipes to arrive;
- He is making good progress on installing new water meters and sensors; and,
- BTE opened some frozen pipes at the lagoon, and it is now discharging. They also hauled 25 loads of donated concrete for the banks of the lagoon;

Fire Department and First Responders

Streets and Town Property

CAO Montgomerie reported that asbestos was found in each of the five buildings tested. The majority was found in flooring adhesive. She will now request estimates for remediation as required for the PSAB asset retirement obligations.

Foreman Desrosiers reported that:

- Street sweeping is scheduled next week;
- Raider asphalt will complete street patching of larger holes on side streets and all holes on Main Street in the next few weeks; and,
- He will gravel roads that are in poor condition.
