

## **Reports from November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025, Regular Council Meeting**

### **Utilities**

Foreman Desrosiers reported that:

- The lagoon has been pumped and should not need to be done again until spring.
- Annual and biannual lagoon and water distribution tests samples have been submitted.
- The hydrants were flushed.
- Dr. Roshani has been taking measurements of the water treatment plant ahead of the conversion project.

CAO Montgomerie reported that a grant application for the water treatment conversion project has been submitted to the Canada Housing Infrastructure Fund.

### **Fire Department and First Responders**

Councillor Wolfe reported that the Fire Department would like to use the landfill burn as a training exercise.

### **Streets and Town Property**

Foreman Desrosiers reported that:

- A snow bucket has been purchased for the grader.
- He filled in the end of a driveway that had sunk after water line repairs a few years ago.
- Flowerpots have been stored for the winter.

Councillor Stack reported that Lunn Street at Railway Avenue has developed a washboard appearance due to the new 3-way stop. Foreman Desrosiers said he will attempt to redistribute the gravel in that area.

### **Finance**

Foreman Desrosiers reported that the renovations at the Asquith & District Sports Centre have finished. CAO Montgomerie reported that updates to the outdoor rink including new puck board and siding for the shelter have started. She also reported that a group is looking to provide skating lessons at the Sports Centre and she is working out the details regarding insurance with them.

Administrator Montgomerie reported that Still Standing Construction should be finished their portion of the renovations at the rink next week.

### **Recreation Committee**
