

Reports from October 8th, 2025, Regular Council Meeting

Utilities

Administrator Montgomerie reported that the annual review of water rates should be completed at the November meeting. Since the revenue from water sales does not cover the expenditures of providing the service the Town is required to review rates and take steps to achieve a self-sustaining water service.

She provided the following reports from Foreman Desrosiers:

Piezo tests were completed at the lagoon this week and the lagoon will be pumped next week. He plans to flush hydrants next week as well.

Fire Department and First Responders

Mayor Stobbe reported that an AFD member is hoping to hold a car wreck simulation to prevent driving under the influence. This would be planned with Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD). They are looking at holding it at the site of the old curling rink in 2026. She will confirm with AFD whether MADD has insurance for this type of event.

Streets and Town Property

Administrator Montgomerie reported that the sportsground booth has been winterized and most trees in town have been trimmed.

Administrator Montgomerie reported that Office Assistant Nicole will be leaving her position when her house sells. There are many resumes to review before scheduling interviews. She will send the resumes to the Personnel Committee and work with them to schedule interviews.
