Utilities

Foreman Desrosiers reported that T&T will be out September 11th to work on the generator at the water treatment plant.

Fire Department and First Responders

Administrator Montgomerie reported that the Asquith First Responders (AFR) have requested the Town use funds from the AFR reserve to cover the cost of AED replacement parts.

Streets and Town Property

Foreman Desrosiers reported that he has been patching potholes with cold mix. He started with the worst of the holes and will continue until he runs out of material.
