

**TOWN ASQUITH
BYLAW NO. 3-2020
A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 13-2015, A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT
OF COUNCIL PROCEDURES BYLAW**

The Council of the Town of Asquith, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 13-2015, be amended by adding the following section:
 7. **Meeting through Electronic Means**
 - a) One or more members of council may participate in a council meeting by means of a telephone, electronic, or other communication facility if:
 - i the members of council provide the administrator with at least two (2) business days' notice of their intent to participate in this manner
 - iii notice of council meeting is given to the public including the way in which the council meeting is to be conducted;
 - iii the facilities enable the public to at least listen to the meeting at a place specified in that notice and the administrator is in attendance at the place: and
 - iv the facilities permit all participants to communicate adequately with each other during the council meeting.
 - 7.1 Members participating in a council meeting held by means of a communication facility are deemed to be present at the council meeting.
