BYLAW NO. 12-2015

A BYLAW RESPECTING FENCES

The Council of the Urban Municipality of the Town of Asquith in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as the Fence Bylaw.
- 2. Fences may be erected or placed along a lot line only in conformance with the following regulations (as referenced in Appendix A and Appendix B):
 - a) No wall or fence located along any lot line, other than those in a required front yard, shall exceed 2 m (6.56 ft.) in height.
 - b) No wall or fence located along any lot line in a required front yard shall exceed 1.219 m (4 ft.) in height.
 - c) In the case of a corner lot, no wall, fence, hedge or shrubs shall exceed 1 m (3.28 ft.) in height in an intersection sight triangle.
- 3. Fencing material for residential properties within the Town limits of the Town of Asquith will be one of the following: wood, vinyl, chain link, or wrought iron.
- 4. The use of electrified fencing material is not allowed within the Town limits.
- 5. This Bylaw shall come into force on August 18, 2015.
