

Reports from January 14th, 2026, Regular Council Meeting

Utilities

Foreman Desrosiers reported that:

- The water treatment plant conversion project is waiting on a permit from the Water Security Agency and for parts to arrive.
- There was a break on the owner's side of the curb stop on Mather Avenue where we repaired a break on the Town's side a few weeks ago. The owner declined to have the copper line replaced on their side when Foreman Desrosiers provided the option during repairs to the Town's side.

Fire Department and First Responders

Councillor Heck reported that he attended the January 6th, 2026, Asquith Fire Department meeting and that Fire Chief Graham and Deputy Chief Ganchar would like more communication between AFD and Council.

Mayor Stobbe and CAO Montgomerie will attend a meeting with the AFD executive and Council Fire Committee members on February 10th, 2026.

Streets and Town Property

CAO Montgomerie reported that a resident requested Council consider providing or facilitating more consistent snow removal at the outdoor rink. Foreman Desrosiers clears the rink with the loader when time permits. He will leave a snow shovel at the outdoor rink for skaters to use when there has been a light snowfall. Councillor Stack noted that there might be ice scrapers at the indoor rink that could be used for the outdoor rink.

Foreman Desrosiers reported that he plans to scrape the snow and ice on Main Street while the temperature is warmer. He also reported that he will need to fix the pins on the snow wing before he can clear streets with driveways.

Finance

CAO Montgomerie reported that the auditors will visit the office February 13th to begin our annual audit.

Waste Disposal

Councillor Wolfe was appointed to the committee.

Rink, Cemetery, Sportsgrounds

Foreman Desrosiers reported that the new scoreboard has been installed at the arena.
