

**THE TOWN OF ASQUITH**

**BYLAW NO. 10-2019**

*A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 6-2015 known as the Zoning Bylaw.*

The Council of the Town of Asquith, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 6-2015 as follows:

1. Section 4.18 “Trailers, Box Cars, Sea and Rail Containers” is amended by removing it in its entirety and is replaced with the following new Section:

***4.18 Trailers, Box Cars, Sea and Rail Containers (Shipping Containers)***

*.1 Shipping containers must comply with Bylaw 6-2019 A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF SHIPPING CONTAINERS WITHIN THE TOWN OF ASQUITH.*

2. Section 7.2 “Discretionary Uses”, is amended by adding a new use immediately following f. Adult daycare (refer to Section 5.7):

g. Shipping container as an accessory use.

3. Section 8.2 “Discretionary Uses”, is amended by adding a new use immediately following g. Residential care home (refer to Section 5.8):

h. Shipping container as an accessory use.

4. Section 9.2 “Discretionary Uses”, is amended by adding a new use immediately following b. Laundromat:

c. Shipping container as an accessory use.

5. Section 10.2 “Discretionary Uses”, is amended by adding a new use immediately following e. Other innovative commercial uses consistent with street level retail and services:

f. Shipping container as an accessory use.

6. Section 11.1 “Discretionary Uses”, is amended by *removing* f. Semi-Trailer and Container Parking Lot including Sea Containers; and is replaced with:

f. Shipping container as an accessory use.

7. Section 12.1 “Permitted Uses”, is amended by *removing* l. Semi-Trailer and Container Parking Lot including Sea Containers; and is replaced with:

l. Shipping container as an accessory use.

8. Section 13.2 “Discretionary Uses”, is amended by adding a new use immediately following a. Wind Energy Facilities (refer to section 5.9):

b. Shipping container as an accessory use.

9. Section 14.2 “Discretionary Uses”, is amended by adding a new use immediately following c. Wind Energy Facilities (refer to Section 5.10):

d. Shipping container as an accessory use.

10. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when adopted by Council.
