

Reports from February 11th, 2026, Regular Council Meeting

Utilities

Foreman Desrosiers reported that:

- The engineer was at the water treatment plant last week to look at the underdrain and take measurements;
- We have received the Permit to Construct from the Water Security Agency for the filtration conversion project and the current plan is to seed the first filter in March.

Fire Department and First Responders

Mayor Stobbe reported that:

- The meeting with AFD executives was productive and that she was given maps showing AFD's fire and rescue response territories;
- There is a territory with no assigned response;
- She plans to meet with the Division 8 Councillor for the RM of Corman Park to discuss that territory as well as the territory north of Asquith;
- The Fire Committee will be looking at increasing fees for fire services; and
- She met with the Reeve for the RM of Vanscoy regarding their planned fire hall that may result in AFD losing response territory. The Reeve reported that the RM plans to be finished construction in two years.

Streets and Town Property

Foreman Desrosiers reported that:

- He has been scraping slush and sanding as needed; and
- The Christmas lights have all been removed except for one near the bulk fill station that was inaccessible at the time.

Finance

CAO Montgomerie reported that the auditors will visit the office February 13th to begin our annual audit.

Waste Disposal

Councillor Wolfe reported that:

- Kielstra Holsteins and Wolfe's Contracting will collect used tires at the Spring Clean Up event again this year;
- He has been speaking with Product Care Recycling about holding a hazardous waste collection even in town, but they usually require a population of greater than 1000;
- Arborscapes has inquired about having a mulch pile at the landfill and would like to discuss an arrangement regarding discounted tree services in exchange for landfill fees.

Rink, Cemetery, Sportsgrounds

Foreman Desrosiers reported that there is a damaged gate at the cemetery that he plans to repair in the spring.
